#### **3. Updates:**

1. Park Security
  - a. Waiting for a bid reply from bandit security out of Santa Cruz.

- b. Auto locks on the pedestrian entrances.
  - c. Herbard Will contact Rose- about the security system he suggests.
  - d. Aromas resident, Matt “Bike guy” was building a mud bike ramp by bathroom. Asked him to stop use of water from bathrooms and to not build a ramp in the park.
  - e. Relocate hazardous materials and objects around the bathroom building.
2. Soccer Field Rental Opportunity
- a. Central Coast FC asked to work with us to invest in a new field. Meeting to be set up after Aromas Day.
3. Marsh Area
- a. Wild Wonder Nature Grant, Mariah found a grant which opens in September to October for \$1000 nature journaling.
  - b. Mariah to invite San Benito agricultural land trust to the space. Watsonville wetlands.
  - c. Mariah and Phil to collaborate sketches and designs for the Marsh Area. Elevated pathways- Bonny example: the bog walk, Victoria example: Sequoia Park. Will meet after Aromas day to work on it.
4. ACCF / AYSC
- a. AYSC Is concerned about maintenance of the mower, need new nets, mower needs a tuneup. AYSC board member, Holly, working with C&N to get the labor for free and share the cost of the parts.
  - b. **MOTION:** (Victor) to have Holly from AYSC get labor for free, and that we will split the labor for the maintenance of the mower. And we agreed to split the cost of buying new nets. Victoria- 2nd. All approved. **Motion Pass.**
5. Aromas Day
- a. Meeting next Saturday. Mowing has begun for Aromas Day.
  - b. Volunteers-more Driscolls employees to help.
  - c. Porta potty’s to be delivered at the park for parking lot: two regular and one handicap.
  - d. Graniterock to drop off cones and Sweep parking lot.
  - e. Leave space for pop up next to Marcus Street entrance.

- a. Kite and Bike Day went really well. Good turn out. Will plan again for next year.
  - b. Aromas Day-

    - ii. Tap Truck wants \$500, then whatever they make in sales that day will split with ACCF.
    - iii. **Motion:** (Bonny) For ACCF to have the top truck at the Granite rock auto show for \$500. Victor 2nd, all agree. **Motion Pass.**
